Dr. Alain Locke Will Do Research Work at Fisk

Washington. Dec. 30.—The time has come for Race colleges to establish an exchange of professors, Alain Leroy Locke, professor of philosphy at Howard university, declared in an interview Monday. Dr. Locke has been granted a leave of absence from Howard university for the winter-guarter. He is going to Fisk university, where he will teach and do research work in social philosophy and on the Race in Hierature. He will return to Howard university at the beginning of the spring quarter and resume his courses.

"I wish it were formally an exchange of professors," he said. "It seems to me that it is time for Negro schools to develop closer relations and co-operation. The time is certain to come—the sooner the better—when Negro schools must pool their educational resources."
