pecuniary profit to any of the organizers, directors or members of said
corporation."

The offices of the corporation are at 289 Fourth Ave., where the Scottsboro Committee is to have on its directorate, in addition to Dr. Haynes, Bill Robinson, the dancer; the Rev. Richard M. Bolden, pastor of the Emanuel church; William H. Davis, publisher of the Amsterdam News; J. Dalmus Steele, real estate operator and fraternal man; the Rev. James W. Brown, pastor of Mother Zion A. M. E. church, and Fred R. Moore, editor of the New York Age.
