## World Brotherhood Urged By Jurist

CHEYNEY, Pa. — The establishment of world brotherhood and a family of nations for the control of modern weapons of war are mandatory if the world is to survive, Judge Jane Bolin of New York's Domestic Relations Court, told the graduating class at Cheyney State Teachers college here last week.

She urged the application of the "New power of students everywhere" toward that end.

"While the scientific world has made great strides forward," Judge Bolin said, "the spiritual and moral side of man is sadly losing ground. Man has thrown aside the Golden Rule and has allowed the greeds and vanities of centuries ago to dominate his life."

Judge Bolin was introduced to the 21 graduates and visitors by Dr. Leslie Pinckney Hill, president of the school. Special music was offered by the Cheyney Chorus, under the direction of Dr. Hill.
