

Baha'i Faith Grows In Africa

WILMETTE, Ill. — Growth of the Baha'i Faith in Africa and Pacific was stressed in a message from International Baha'i Headquarters, Haifa, Israel, to 700 delegates and observers attending the 51st annual national convention being held here, April 23, through 26, at the Baha'i House of Worship.

Two hundred and forty-three African tribes are now represented in the Faith. In the countries and islands under the jurisdiction of the four regional national assemblies in Africa, the number of believers is nearly 9,000 which includes a 50 per cent gain in the past year in Northwest Africa.
