

Ed Berry To Talk At Bahai's Banquet Sat.

"The Current Dilemma" will be discussed by Edwin C. Berry executive director of the Chicago Urban League, Saturday during the Baha'i's commemorative banquet in the Conrad Hilton Hotel.

Some 3,000 Baha'i's are attending the faith's Intercontinental Conference in Wilmette and Chicago. They are discussing ways and means of proclaiming the Baha'i Faith during the next several years and are hearing reports on the progress of the Faith throughout the world.
