

Top Chemist To Speak At Baha'i House

Dr. William Baker, of Deerfield, will speak Sunday, Feb. 18 at 3:45 p.m. at the Baha'i House of Worship, Sheridan Road at Linden ave., Sunday, Feb. 18, at 3:45 p.m. The title of his lecture will be "Thou Art Even as a Finely Tempered Sword. . ."

Currently a research chemist at Abbott Laboratories, Dr. Baker received his Ph.D. in Chemistry from the Illinois Institute of Technology, where he had earlier received a Master of Science degree in Food Technology.

He has served on a number of national Baha'i committees, and has at different times been Chairman of the Spiritual Assemblies of the Baha'is of Champaign and of Deerfield, Illinois.

The title of Dr. Baker's talk is from a passage in Baha'i Scripture: "O My servant! Thou art even as a finely tempered sword concealed in the darkness of its sheath and its value hidden from the artificer's knowledge. Wherefore come forth from the sheath of self and desire that thy worth may be made resplendent and manifest unto all the world."
