It is of special interest during this national holiday weekend to consider that the son of the Baha'i prophet was in the United States in 1912 and in his talks at that time forecast much of the social furmal which confronts our turmoil which confronts our country today, and at the same our

country today, and at the same time indicated the spiritual greatness that could be the na-tion's if the nation turned to-ward God. Mr. Mitchell, has been Sec-retary of the National Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is of the United States for the past year, and a resident of Wilmette for two years. He was head of the Department of Youth and Col-lege Activities before being elected to his present position. elected to his present position. Mr. Mitchell holds a bachelor's degree from Shaw University, and Master's in Journalism from Columbia University. He has served on the faculty of Howard University in Washing-ton and as coefficient of the ton, and as co-editor of the magazine "Africa Report."
